Phonics Screening Results 2017:

Children in Year 1 in 2016-17 made exceptional progress in their learning of Phonics.

94.1% of Year 1 children were 'Working at' the standard when they were tested during the phonics screening week. The National Average for Year 1 Phonics was 81% in 2016.

Y2 Phonics data for 2017: Y1 (2016) and Y2 (2017) combined => **100%** of children achieved the phonics standard by the end of Y2.

2016 **85% of Y1** achieved the standard and of those who were retested in 2017 **100%** of children who were Wt in Y1 achieved standard in Y2.

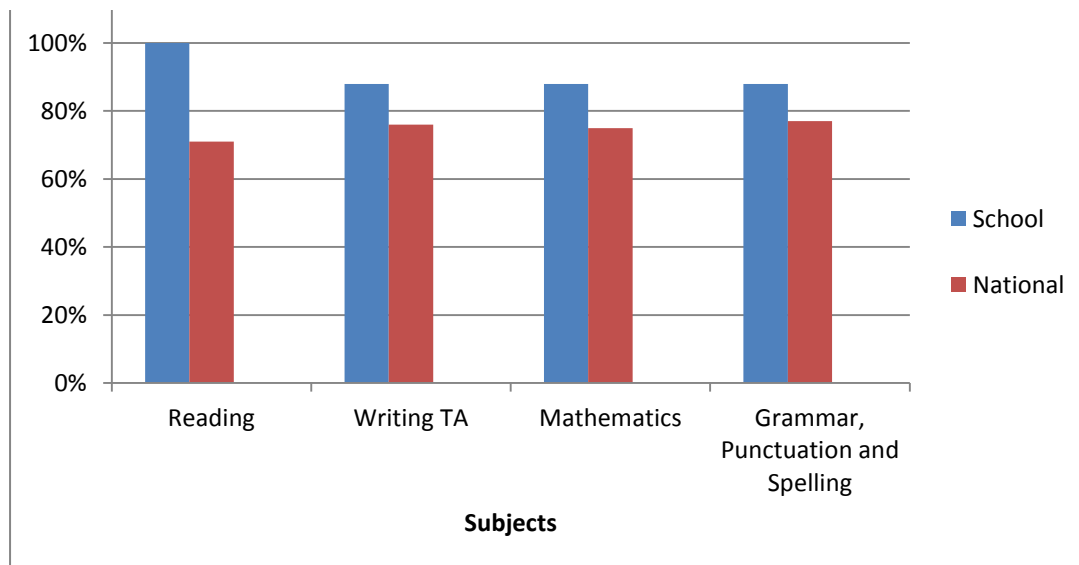

Results show that the school is performing above the National Average in all subject areas. It also shows that the children are above the NA in achieving 'the standard' in reading, writing and maths combined – with 75% achieving the standard compared with 61% Nationally.
