Phonics Screening results 2018:

Children in Year 1 in 2017-18 made very good progress in their learning of Phonics.

89% of Year 1 children attained 'Working at' the phonics standard when they were tested during the phonics screening week. The National Average for Year 1 phonics was 81% in 2017, consequently children performed better than the National Average.

Year 2 Phonics data for 2018: 100% of Year 2 children who did not make the 'standard' in Year 1 achieved the standard by the end of Year 2.

The Phonics results over the last three years show that Our Lady Star of the Sea Year 1 children have consistently performed above the National Average in this area.


