Phonics Screening results 2019:

Children in Year 1 in 2018-19 made good progress in their learning of Phonics.

72% of Year 1 children attained 'Working at' the phonics standard when they were tested during the phonics screening week.

Year 2 Phonics data for 2018: 50% of Year 2 children who did not make the 'standard' in Year 1 achieved the standard by the end of Year 2. This means 94.4% of Year 2 children have achieved the phonics standard.


