Wednesday Word

- Wednesday Word handouts for the next few weeks have been provided. Each Wednesday, sit with family to complete a reflection on the weeks Gospel.
- Share the story together.
- Talk about the meaning and message from the story.
- Complete the activities on the sheet together.
- In your Wednesday Word book, respond to the Gospel by:
 - writing a prayer
 - > drawing a picture
 - > wrting some key words from the gospel
 - > explaining the meaning
 - > retelling the story
 - > writing a sentence about the story

This piece of work should be completed with thought and care. It should include a little writing and should be neatly presented.

Since the children are off school over Easter, they are missing what the church considers the most important time of the Liturgical year: Holy Week.

In the books provided and as the RE part of the timetable, share the stories of Holy Week with your child. Use an online bible for kids or Youtube to find the different stories. Read them together and discuss them. Using the images provided in the pack, get your child to choose the appropriate one, stick it in their books and write a few sentences retelling what happens. This does not have to be pages of writing but 2 or 3 simple sentences. E.g.

Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey.

The crowds stood all around.

They shouted Hosanna! Hosanna!
