Paul spent over 30 years travelling on foot, horseback and by boat.

He wanted to spread the Good News to Gentiles.

The Acts of the Apostles tells about Paul's journeys and adventures. He was shipwrecked and imprisoned many times.

Paul would set up a Christian community in one place and then move on to set up another. He kept in contact with all of the communities by writing letters, offering them advice and encouragement.
