
RE Unit - Rules

Introduction


- Talk about how rules are important. Can you think of rules for different situations or scenarios? EG) at home, in school, crossing a road, playing a football match ect.

- Write a recount about a time when you have done something on purpose that wasn't kind and a time when you did something accidently. How did you feel? How did the other person/ people feel? How did you resolve the problem?
