Dear Year2 and Year3 parents,

Update re isolation period

Further to the letter sent to you on Sunday 16th November, we have received updated advice regarding the isolation period for children and staff linked to Class 2. The new advice is that the 14 day isolation period will start from Thursday 12th November which means that staff and children isolating will start back in school on Friday 27th November 2020.

Please note:

You do not need to have your child tested unless they have symptoms of the COVID19 virus:

- > High temperature
- A new and continuous cough
- Loss of taste and or smell

In some cases children may have headaches or tummy upsets.

If your child is tested between now and the end date of the isolation period and the test is positive – your child and family will have to follow NHS isolation guidance. You will also need to notify the school.

If your child is tested between now and the end date of the isolation period and the test is negative – your child will have to continue to isolate and then return to school on the 27th November.

I apologise for any inconvenience this may cause, however, the health and safety of all our staff and pupils is high priority.

Miss Hutton will be posting work throughout the isolation period and work packs (exercise books and stationery) can be collected from school at the usual Class 2 pick-up time ie. between 3:30 and 3:40pm.
