Reading and writing

YR-

- Name recognition and writing
- Engaging in extended conversations about stories, learning and exploring lots of new vocabulary
- Begin to read individual letters by saying the correct sounds for them (phase 2)
- Begin to blend sounds into words so that they can read short words.
- Form some lower-case and capital letters correctly. —

- Spell words containing taught phonemes and some CEW
- -Use adjectives after adult modelling
